**DAY 01
(MON)**

14 DEC ARRIVE DELHI

Arrive at **Delhi International** airport by flight.



After clearing customs and immigration formalities, proceed towards the arrival lounge of the airport where you will be welcomed with garlands and assisted by our representative.

Later, transfer to the hotel (*rooms booked for immediate occupancy*).

Delhi is a city that defies a one-line description as the capital of India or as the capital of the world's largest democracy. Actually, Delhi is India in miniature. Delhi is 3,287,263 sq. km of India's fantastic variety compressed into 1483 sq. km. Over the millennia, it has wooed rulers, attracted plunderers, and tried historians with so many details. Today, even as it preserves an enviable heritage, Delhi is a true cosmopolitan city always on the move. Delhi remains the centre of power. Once it was a city of royal power. Then it became the seat of colonial power. Later it was the seat of bureaucratic power. The seat of political power it has always been. Today it is emerging as an important centre for corporate power too. However, the most fascinating aspect of this city is its cosmopolitan nature.

(TUE)**

15 DEC DELHI

Late morning proceed for a guided tour of the city.

You begin your India experience by a guided visit to the **Old Delhi**, visiting the historic **Red Fort** - Shah Jehan's elegant citadel in red sandstone, which was built as an octagon. Very near the Fort is the **Jama Masjid** (Friday Mosque), India's largest mosque, also built by Shah Jahan. See the colorful bazaar of **Chennai Chowk** and take a walk through the back streets of Old Delhi to get a first hand experience of the hustle and bustle of this traditional city. This ride through the small by-lanes will be most fascinating. Also visit **Raj Ghat** - the memorial to Mahatma Gandhi.



Later return to **New Delhi** visiting the **Qutab Minar** (Qutab's Tower) is a key record of the first encounters between Islam and Hinduism in north India. Shortly before sunset we visit an architectural pearl – **Humayun's Tomb**. This architectural gift to history from Emperor Humayun's widow prefigures the Taj Mahal and shows Moghul refinement at its zenith.

Evening at leisure for independent activities.

Breakfast will be served on board the train by the railways.

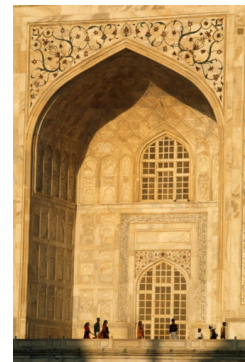


Agra is famous as the home to one of the Seven Wonders of the World - the Taj Mahal. The architectural splendor of the mausoleums, the fort and the palaces in Agra is a vivid reminder of the opulence of the legendary Mughal Empire. Agra was their capital for nearly a hundred years from 1564. A pleasant town, with a comparatively easy pace, Agra is known for its superb inlay work on marble and soapstone, by artisans who are hereditary craft persons. The city is also famous for its carpets, gold thread embroidery and leather shoes.

**DAY 03
(WED)**

16 DEC DELHI/ AGRA/ DELHI/ MUMBAI

Meeting and assistance on arrival at the railway station and proceed on the city tour.



Visit the **Taj Mahal** - the inimitable poem in white marble and see its glory in the Sunset. Built over a period of 22 years, by the Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan in 1630, for his Queen Mumtaz Mahal to enshrine her mortal remains, it is one of the seven modern wonders of the World.

Later visit the **Agra Fort**, built by three Mughal Emperors starting from Akbar the Great in 1565 AD, which is a masterpiece of design and construction. Within the fort are a number of exquisite buildings including the Moti Masjid, Jahangir's Palace, Khas Mahal and the Sheesh Mahal, Diwane-i-Am, Diwane-i-Khas and Musamman Burj, where Emperor Shah Jahan, the fifth Mughal Emperor, died a prisoner.

Afternoon drive to Delhi (**210 kms/5½ hrs**) in time to board the onward flight for Mumbai. Arrive Delhi and check in to your flight.
